This CyberPower notebook was released just in time for Memorial Day this past year and from boot-up forward we think you'll be impressed with the overall performance offered by the system that contains many components found in competitive system that cost considerably much higher. The American Patriots Edition Notebook uses AMD processing technology while offering a nice amount of storage space and it wins our Editor's Choice Award for speed and value.

The American Patriots Edition notebook includes an AMD 2.2GHz Turion 64 MT-40 processor that utilizes the chipmaker's HyperTransport technology. It is equipped with 1MB of Level 2 cache and the maximum 2GB of PC-3200 400MHz DDR SDRAM memory. Most owners will be satisfied with storage capacity available with the unit's 5400-RPM 120GB Ultra ATA 100 hard drive. Users will be able to burn their favorite media with the computer's 8X DVD+/-RW optical drive.

CyberPower integrates an ATI Mobility Radeon X1600 chipset with 256MB of dedicated RAM to power the computer's 15.4-inch widescreen WXGA LCD display. We were totally impressed with the color comparison tests that show no variance in color representation. With a 1280x800 maximum resolution, we found Windows small fonts easy to read at this particular setting. This laptop also includes a 1.3-megapixel web came at the top of the LCD display, negating the need to purchase one as an optional item.

Network connectivity available with the American Patriots Edition notebook includes an 802.11b/g wireless interface and a single 10/100Base-T Ethernet port as well as a v.92-compliant fax-modem when broadband services are unavailable. The base system of this series includes a 1.83GHz Intel Core 2 Duo Mobile T5600 Dual-Core Processor with 2MB of Level 2 cache. The system comes with 512MB of Corsair DDR2-SDRAM that can be upgraded to 2GB. The base unit includes a 5400-RPM 40GB hard drive although a 160GB drive is available. Users can watch their favorite movies or burn DVD media with the notebook's 8X CD-DVD+/-RW optical drive. This is one of the few notebooks that we've reviewed that does include a carrying case at no extra charge.

The CyberPower Xplorer X5-3800 notebook uses an integrated ATI Mobility Radeon X1400 chipset with 128MB of RAM to power the unit's 15.4inch diagonal widescreen LCD display. With a maximum resolution of 1200x800 we found Windows small fonts well defined and easy to read. Our color comparison tests produced no surprises during the review process. While the notebook does include an integrated v.92compliant fax-modem and 10/100Base-T Ethernet port, wireless networking is available through an Intel Pro/Wireless 3945 802.11a/b/g 54Mbps MiniPCI Card.
